Plant Description	<p>Anethum graveolens, commonly known as dill, is an annual herb in the Apiaceae family, native to the Mediterranean and West Asia. It has feathery, aromatic leaves and produces yellow flowers in umbrella-shaped clusters. Both its leaves (dill weed) and seeds are widely used for culinary and medicinal purposes. Dill aids digestion, is used in pickling, and contains essential oils like carvone and limonene. It grows best in sunny, well-drained soil and is sensitive to transplanting scent-height around 40-60cm often found with parsley , coriander, or in mixed vegetable gardens , and also used in traditional medication for digestion and as a flavoring in food , cultivated in gardens and fields at sunny areas with – drained soil.</p>
