Plant Description	<p><b>Color:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Leaves:</b> Light to medium green, slightly veined</li> <li>• <b>Bracts (not petals):</b> Bright magenta/pink</li> <li>• <b>True Flowers:</b> Tiny, white tubular flowers in center (not very visible in this sample)</li> </ul> <p><b>Size:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Stem Length:</b> ~30–100 cm on collection</li> <li>• <b>Leaf Size:</b> 4–7 cm long, ovate shape</li> <li>• <b>Bracts:</b> 2–4 cm long, papery</li> </ul> <p><b>Odor:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Leaves and Flowers:</b> Mild or neutral aroma when crushed</li> </ul> <p><b>Structure:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Climbing or trailing woody vine with thorny stems</li> <li>• Leaves alternate, simple, with smooth margins</li> <li>• Bracts are showy and surround small flowers</li> <li>• Fast-growing with flexible stems</li> </ul> <p><b>Other Features:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Common in warm climates and used for hedges, trellises, and wall decoration</li> <li>• Drought-tolerant and thrives in full sun</li> <li>• Traditionally used for anti-inflammatory and antimicrobial purposes</li> </ul>
