Plant Description	<p>English ivy is an evergreen climbing vine with woody stems. It has glossy, dark green leaves with 3–5 lobes and prominent light veins. The plant uses aerial rootlets to cling to walls, trees, and ground surfaces.</p> <p>Underground roots spread to anchor the plant and absorb water and nutrients.</p> <p>The leaves: Evergreen (stay green all year).Leathery and glossy on top texture , lighter beneath. No obvious hairs on the leaf surfaces — the leaves are generally smooth, leathery, and glossy,The upper surface is hairless and shiny.</p> <p>Appearance:A vigorous, woody climbing vine or groundcover.</p> <p>Stems are slender but woody, with small rootlets that attach to surfaces.</p> <p>In landscapes, it forms dense mats or climbs trees, fences, and walls.</p> <p>Generally, no strong Odour when healthy.</p> <p>The leaves may have a mild, slightly earthy or green smell when crushed.</p> <p>It produce latex which is small amount, milky white, sticky/watery texture, may cause skin irritation.</p>
