In the first year, it forms a rosette of leaves; in the second year, it produces tall flowering stems with small yellow-green flowers in umbels. The taproot is slender and white.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Widely used as a fresh herb in cooking. • Source of vitamins A, C, and K, and minerals like iron and potassium. • Traditionally used in herbal medicine as a diuretic, digestive aid, and for kidney and urinary health.
