Plant Description	<p>Rosa damascena is a deciduous perennial shrub belonging to the Rosaceae family. It typically grows to a height of 1.5 to 2.5 meters and is characterized by:</p> <p>Woody, erect stems with curved thorns Pinnate compound leaves with 5 to 7 serrated leaflets Large, fragrant pink flowers, usually blooming in spring to early summer Flowers are double-petaled and highly valued for their essential oil content The plant is drought-tolerant and thrives in well-drained loamy soils with full sun exposure The species is traditionally cultivated for its aromatic petals, which are harvested for rose oil, rose water, and cosmetic, culinary, and medicinal purposes.</p>
